Artist Karen Carr's rendering of a pair of 230 million-year-old *Herrerasaurus* allows visitors to The Field Museum's new *Evolving Planet* exhibition to imagine what some of the world's oldest dinosaurs may have looked like. In addition to Carr's dramatic illustrations, the exhibition features hands-on interactive displays, videos of Field Museum scientists and hundreds of fossils. All of the features trace the history of 4 billion years of life and evolution on Earth.
