*Tutankhamun and the Golden Age of the Pharaohs*  
May 26, 2006 through January 1, 2007

With tour groups in mind, The Field Museum is pleased to announce several itinerary concepts that revolve around this exhibition.

**Suggested Group Itineraries**

• **Adult and Senior Groups**

- Visit the *King Tutankhamun* exhibition at The Field Museum.
- Add a stop at a **local perfumery**, and learn first-hand from **Marilyn Miglin** about ancient oils and their Egyptian origins. While there, you can also sample the \$500 an ounce fragrance that originated from perfume recipes etched in hieroglyphs inside Egyptian temples!
- Explore more of the ancient Egyptian culture at the **Oriental Institute**, **Art Institute of Chicago**, or with an Egyptian-themed film at IMAX on **Navy Pier**.
- Embark on the “King Tut Strut” Bakery Tour or “Eat Like a King” Lunch and Tour at **Eli’s Cheesecake World and Café**.
- Consider a walking “Tomb Tour” within the quiet beauty of **Graceland Cemetery**, where you can view the final resting place of Chicago giants like Potter Palmer, George Pullman, Marshall Field, and others.
- Let **Marshall Field’s** spark your culinary imagination with “Inspirations from Tut’s Tomb” as you experience a demonstration of Egyptian cooking in the culinary studio complete with buffet!
- Leave time to cruise like a pharaoh on an **architectural boat tour** of the Chicago River or explore **Egyptian-inspired architecture on a walking tour** (or with a step-on guide).
- Learn how Egyptian rulers developed one of the first systems of banking when you visit the **Chicago Federal Reserve Bank** for a guided tour.
- End your day in style. **Lawry’s The Prime Rib** will treat you like royalty while you dine on a traditional Egyptian meal of hummus, your choice of soup or salad and several entrees with Egyptian seasonings, followed by dessert fit for a king. Pyramid beer completes your experience.
